

Children ages birth-five who are registered with the program receive a free age-appropriate book mailed to their home each month and two literacy activities.

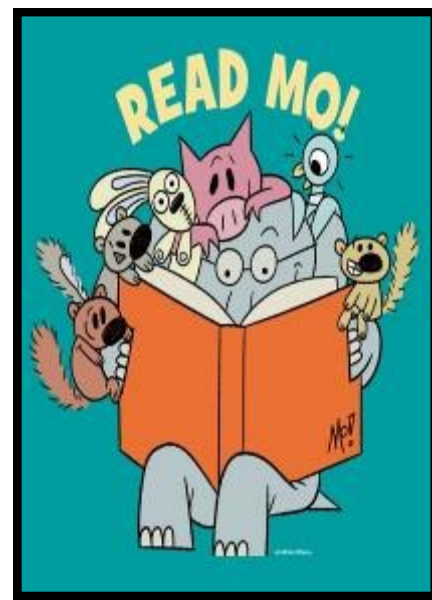
