I have worked at the library for 4 years. I started in the Children's Department and now work in Adult Patron Services.

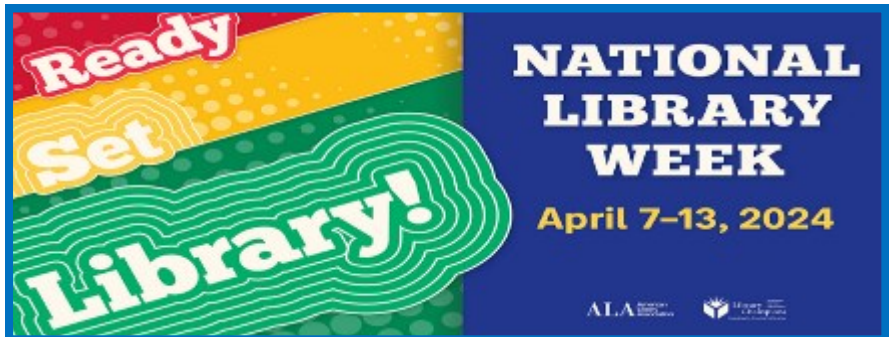
I enjoy helping patrons in the library, reading books from my ever growing list of book recommendations, and learning something new every day.

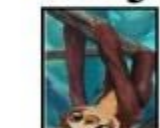


